WHEN WORK RUNS US RAGGED, we tend to want to rest our heads in a space that makes the rat race worth the stress.

In creating a master bedroom for a young professional, design firm Bassman Blaine Home aimed to deliver a retreat that was restorative, yet sophisticated.

“The design of the home is feminine chic — an abode for a well-traveled, single female to find comfort with class when she returns from her business trips,” said design principal Ken Bassman. “The space was a blank canvas. Our client purchased the last spec home from a builder in this tract. All the paint, tile, flooring was completed. We came in and warmed up the space by adding wallpaper, area rugs, accent lighting that represented our client.”

The master bedroom maintains a fresh, clean vibe while exuding

layered elegance at the same time — a result of mixing the metallic nightstands, velvet mauve pillows with a luxurious sheen and crystals in both the lamps and chandelier.

“The design called for an exceptional chandelier to complete a room fit for a queen,” Bassman said. “The chandelier in the master bedroom is made of crystal and plated chrome for a sophisticated statement.”

A tufted headboard and lush bedding are icing on the cake in a space that was informed by inspiration found in the trendy resurgence of blush tones.

“We gathered our inspiration from all the blush advertisements, fabrics and furniture items being introduced last spring,” Bassman said. “We knew our client had very high-end taste, and we wanted to reflect that in our overall design.”
